

NetSci 2014: Information for participants

1. Registration Desk

- Conference Registration Desk is in Building 14 (The Conference Center).
- Dormitory Registration Desk is in Building 1.

2. Coffee and break service

Morning Coffee: From 8-9am all mornings basic coffee service is provided in the Conference Center (Bldg 14) lobby. There are no refreshments included, only hot drinks.

Coffee Break locations:

- Monday and Tues, there will be three coffee break locations:
 - The Main Courtyard (servicing Buildings 3, 4, 7, 8)
 - Building 10 (servicing EDR and Garden Room)
 - Building 14 (servicing Krutch, Room 102, John Kearny Room)

Weds, Thurs, and Fri:

- Mornings; Building 14
- Afternoons; Building 14 and Building 10

3. Contributed Oral Talks

All contributed talks are allocated 20 mins in total. This includes any necessary computer set up time and audience Q & A.

4. Poster Display and Poster Sessions

All posters will be displayed in the Ginko Courtyard of the Clark Kerr Campus. Display boards will be ready on Monday afternoon and available until Friday morning. Presenters are welcome to display their posters this entire time. We request that posters be displayed during the official poster session Thursday evening, 5:40-7:30pm, but having posters available all week should enhance the scientific exchange. Please note, we have rented a tent to cover the entire courtyard, so posters will stay dry from any potential rain, but there is the possibility of condensation in the mornings.

If you RSVP'd, your name and poster title are included in the list of posters. Please refer to that document to find the number assigned to your poster. All the poster display boards are accordingly numbered. If you did not RSVP we may be able to accommodate your poster, but you must check in with the main administrator at the conference registration desk to inquire for space.

5. Lunch options

If you are staying in the dorms, breakfast and lunch are included. If you purchased a meal card, lunch is in the same dining hall in Building 10. The dining hall facilities have agreed to allow onsite purchase of individual breakfast and lunch tickets. Additionally, there are a few coffee shops scattered in the Clark Kerr vicinity (see "Lodging/Meals" tab of the conference web page).

Connect to network ID: "RESCOMP". Log on as "Conference Attendee" and follow instructions. When prompted, the "Conference Identifier" is "NetSci" and "Verification Code" is "2014".
